

Channel Assignment

The Channel Assignment function allows you to reassign almost any receiver channel to a different transmitter channel. For example, the receiver gear channel could be re-assigned to the transmitter throttle channel.

- 1. Access the Channel assignment function from the System List, which opens the Rx Port Assignment Screen.
- 2. Scroll to the receiver channel you wish to change.
- 3. Press the scroll wheel once and scroll left or right to change the receiver channel.
- 4. Press the scroll wheel a second time to save the selection.

The "Channel Sources" screen has been renamed "Channel Input Config" and the "X-Plus Input" screen has been renamed "X-Plus Input Config".
